NOTICE: IMPROVEMENT EXAMINATIONS

Students who have graduated in 2015 and who are desirous of doing improvement examinations may apply for these examinations on or before 31 March 2016. The regulations which related to Improvement Examinations are given below. The following guidelines may be kept in mind:

- 1. A student may apply for at least 6 courses (B.Tech), 4 courses (MCA) or 3 courses (other programmes) from among those offered during the SPRING semester for improvement.
- 2. The syllabi for these examinations will be the current syllabi of the University for these Courses.
- 3. While a student who has taken Migration Certificate from the University is not eligible to appear for the improvement examinations.

Regulations Concerning Improvement Examinations

- After the completion of the entire programme of study, a student may be allowed the
 provision of improvement examinations. These are to be availed of only once each in the
 Autumn and Spring semesters that immediately follow the completion of the programme,
 and within the maximum number of years permissible for a programme.
- A student who has taken migration from the university shall not be eligible to appear for Improvement Examination.
- A student may not choose more than twelve courses (B.Tech six in the Autumn semester and six in the Spring semester), eight courses (MCA – four in the Autumn semester and four in the Spring semester) or six courses (other programmes – three in the Autumn semester and three in the Spring semester) for improvement examinations.
- After the improvement examination, the better of the two grades obtained (the old and the new) shall be considered for the calculation of SGPA and CGPA.
- If the student improves his/her grades through the improvement examination, new grade sheets and comprehensive transcripts shall be issued to the student.
