- (A) Eligibility: (For Bengali, Chemistry, Psychology, Zoology, Law, Geography & Disaster Management, Hindi, Botany, Forestry & Biodiversity, Rural Management & Development, English, Statistics, Journalism & Mass Communication, Sanskrit & History).
- (I) Good academic record having at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject, from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- (II) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- (III) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) of clause 4.4.1 of UGC regulations 2010, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the university grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.

(IV) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Degree Programmes in discipline for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted. Monthly remuneration (fixed) as per the University rules.

(B) Eligibility: (For Music)

- (I) Good academic record having at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject, from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- (II) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) of clause 4.4.2.1 of UGC regulations 2010, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the university grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- (III) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Degree Programmes in discipline for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted. Monthly remuneration (fixed) as per the University rules.

OR

- i. A traditional and a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:
 - (a) Studied under noted/reputed traditional masters and has thorough knowledge to explain the subject concerned;
 - (b) A high grade artist of AIR/TV; and
 - (c) Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

(C) Eligibility: (For Visual (FINE) Arts.

- (I) Good academic record having at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject, from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- (II) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) of clause 4.4.2.3 of UGC regulations 2010, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the university grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- (III) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's Degree Programmes in discipline for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted. Monthly remuneration (fixed) as per the University rules.

- i. A Professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the concerned subject, who should have:
 - First class Diploma in Visual (Fine) arts discipline from the recognized Institution of India/Abroad;
 - 2. Five years of experience of holding regular regional/National exhibitions/Workshops with evidence; and
 - 3. Ability to explain the logical reasoning of the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in that discipline.

(D) Eligibility: (For Computer Science & Engineering and Information Technology)

i. Essential

First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech).

- ii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
 - 1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 - 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.

(E) Eligibility: (For Pharmacy)

- i. Essential:
- 1. A basic degree in pharmacy (B.Pharm).
- 2. Registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948, as amended from time to time, including any succeeding enactments.
- 3. First Class Master's Degree in appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy.
- ii. Desirable:
 - Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 and
 - 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.

(F) Eligibility: (For Kokborok)

- (i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in any language subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university and must have Degree/Diploma in Kokborok language & Literature from any Indian University:
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET;
- (iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii), candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- (iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in discipline for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Monthly remuneration shall be as per Tripura University norms.

Intending candidate may attend with Bio-data and relevant original documents and a set of Photocopy.

Candidate should report at least half an hour before the commencement of the interview.

No TA/DA shall be paid for attending the interview.
